# THE STARTING 5

- Elizabethtown College, now in its 90th season of intercollegiate wo men's basketball, opens its 11-game home regular season schedule against the Eastern University Eagles out of the MAC Freedom Conference this evening. The Blue Jays have won all three matchups between the two schools, including a 52-49 win at St. Davids, Pa. last season.
- Multiple players posted career-high totals last Wednesday at Lebanon Valley. **Emma Hoesman** dished out a game-high 9 assists and finished a point shy of a double-double (9pts, 9ast). Abby Beyer torched the Dutchmen with 5 made threes and a game-high 22 points. Lydia Lawson added 18 points and Mikayla Ruth contributed 16 in the Jays' fourth consecutive victory over LVC.
- E-town was back at Franklin & Marshall's Terry Greene Memorial Tournament to defend its' title from last season. The Jays opened up the two-game tournament with a 72-63 win over Stevens. Five players were in double digits for EC, including Beyer (13), Ruth (11), Lawson (11), Veronica Christ (11), and Ashley Reynolds (10). Christ and Reynolds combined for 21 of the team's 25 bench points in the win.

The win sent the Blue Jays back to the championship game, where they faced the host Diplomats. After trailing by 14 at the half, Elizabethtown battled back in the third and fourth quarters to get within four with 2:03 left in the game. F&M pulled away from that point to claim the tournament crown. Hoesman was named to the All-Tournament Team.

- 21st-ranked Messiah outscored Eastern in three of the four quarters of their non-conference game last Wednesday. The Eagles got off to a slow start as the Falcons outscored them 18-8 in the first. EU closed the gap to five by halftime and trailed 33-28 after two quarters. Messiah stretched its lead to 11 by the end of the third and made it 14 by the end of the game, a 76-62 win for the Falcons, **Regie Robinson** led the Eagles with 19 points (9-15 FG) while **Taylor Azer** added 10 points. Robinson has been Eastern's offensive leader through 4 games, averaging a team-high 16.5ppg and 10.0rpg.
- The Blue Jays will play six more contests before the New Year arrives, with five of those here at Thompson Gym. E-town hosts Moravian on Saturday, Dec. 2 in the Landmark Conference opener for both teams. Game time is 4 p.m.
