# THE STARTING 5

- 1 Elizabethtown ran its unbeaten record against Goucher to 8-0 on January 20 with a 75-26 win in Towson, Md. E-town and Goucher have played since 1998-99 and the Blue Jays have won all seven meetings in Landmark Conference play against the Gophers.
- The Blue Jays begin a critical three-game stretch to finish out the regular season, which includes two of three here at Thompson Gymnasium where E-town is 8-1. Elizabethtown and Catholic currently sit in a tie for third place, with the Cardinals holding the head-to-head (1-0) tiebreaker. The two teams play on Wednesday on this court.
- **3** Elizabethtown's past three games were all on the road, where EC went 1-2. The Jays came away with a 73-68 win at Drew in large part to career highs from **Mikayla Ruth** (26pts) and **Marissa Emlet** (14pts). 21 of Ruth's 26 came in the second half as E-town outscored Drew 42-29 in the second half to pull off the five-point win in Madison, N.J.

**Emma Powell** had a team-high 19 points in Saturday's loss at Moravian, a season-high for the first-year player. Ruth and Emlet were both in double figures for a second straight game. **Ashley Reynolds** was the third different leading scorers for Elizabethtown in the last three games at Juniata. She put up a team-high 17 points as the Jays' comeback attempt fell short against the Eagles, 64-59.

- 4 Goucher shot a season-best against Alvernia when they put up a season-high in points, made free throws, and free throws attempted. The Gophers went to the line 31 times and hit on 23 of them, over a 74 percent clip. **Nicole Wolard** had a season-high 20 points and with her 11 rebounds, secured one of her nine double-doubles on the season. She also shot 10-for-12 from the charity stripe in the game against the Crusaders. Wolard averages 13.2ppg, while **Nailah Jones** is Goucher's second-leading scorer at 8.8ppg.
- 5 Elizabethtown will host Catholic on Wednesday, February 14, in a pivotal Landmark Conference matchup with playoff ramifications. Game time is 7 p.m.
