## THE STARTING 5

**1** Elizabethtown and Juniata have one of the longer established all-time series in Blue Jays' program history. E-town has won 50 of 70 all-time meetings with the Eagles since 1930-31. The Jays are 6-0 against Juniata since joining the Landmark Conference.

**2** Elizabethtown won big in both games this past week. It started with a 23-point win over Drew at Thompson Gym. E-town led by as many as 30 in the game and shot a season-best 47.5% from the floor while holding the Rangers to 12 or fewer points in three of the four quarters. **Ashley Reynolds** had a team-high 17 pts and 8 rebounds. **Veronica Christ** added 12 pts and **Abby Beyer** recorded 11 pts and three treys off the bench.

Beyer led three players in double figures on Saturday in a win at Goucher. Beyer had a game-high 18 pts and another five threes. Her 41 treys on the season tie a season career-high and ranks second in the Landmark Conference. Reynolds had 12 pts and 12 reb. and **Rachel Liszkiewicz** tied a season-high with 10 pts of her own off the bench.

**3** The lone blemish on Juniata's schedule is a loss at Drew on Jan. 13. Prior to that game, the Eagles were on a 14-game win streak to start the season, including two tournament titles. The Eagles beat host Randolph-Macon and Bridgewater (Va.) on opening weekend at the R-MC Tip-Off Classic. In December, Juniata took down St. Lawrence and Delaware Valley on back-to-back days to win the Juniata College Holiday Classic.

Juniata has already topple perennial Landmark Conference favorites Scranton, Catholic, and Moravian so far this season. Led by **Dani Atkinson's** 14.9 ppg (3rd in the Landmark) and **Morgan Instone's** 7.7 rpg (3rd) and 52.7 FG% (5th), the Eagles are currently the team to beat in the conference at 5-1.

**4** Diversity in scoring has helped the Blue Jays, who are the only team in the league with 4 players that avg. 10.0+ ppg.

**5** Elizabethtown will host Scranton on Saturday, January 27, at 4 p.m.
