## THE STARTING 5

**1** Last year marked the first time since joining the Landmark Conference that one team was able to take both regular season matchups from the other. Moravian escaped E-town in Bethlehem, Pa. by two points before hanging on against the Blue Jays at Thompson Gymnasium by five later in the season. Elizabethtown still leads the all-time 45-28-2.

**2** Elizabethtown had 21 trips to the free throw line this past Wednesday against Eastern, the fourth such game E-town has had at least 20 FTA in a game this season. The Jays converted 15 of those 21 attempts, including 10 of 12 in the second half to help EC come away with a one-point victory.

The Eagles had the last shot attempt, but the ball clanged off the rim as time expired. **Mikayla Ruth** led the Blue Jays with a team-high 16 points, her fifth straight game in double figures. The sophomore is the fifth-leading scorer in the Landmark Conference at 14.0 ppg.

**3 Abby Beyer** (11.4ppg) and **Lydia Lawson** (10.4ppg) join Ruth as the other Blue Jays averaging double digits on the season. Elizabethtown is one of three teams in the conference with at least three players scoring at a 10.0+ ppg clip. Moravian's **Camille McPherson** (15.8ppg) is second in the Landmark, while **Maddie Capuano** (13.8ppg) is sixth.

Capuano leads the league in free throws attempted, while McPherson is second. Beyer is second in FT percentage, of those with at least 10 FTA (15-17, 88.2%) this season. The Blue Jays also average just 13.4 TO/game, the fewest among Landmark Conference teams, and are second in 3pt FG% and third in 3pt FG% defense.

**4 Karlie Brogan** and **Jennifer McClave** led the Greyhounds in their most recent win, an 80-57 victory against Wilkes. The duo each scored 13 points to help Moravian to a fifth straight win after an opening season loss against Muhlenberg.

**5** The Blue Jays will have a one-day break in between games. Gettysburg visits Thompson Gymnasium for a non-conference game on Monday, December 4 at 7 p.m.
