THE STARTING 5

- 1 Elizabethtown and Scranton face each other for the second time in a three-week span. The Royals won the previous matchup, at the John Long Center on Saturday, January 6, 78-63.
- The Blue Jays made it 7 for 7 at Thompson Gymnasium on Wednesday night with a statement win over #23 Juniata, 79-55. E-town shot over 42% as a team for the third consecutive game, their longest such streak of the season. The win also moved Elizabethtown into a second-place tie with the Eagles. The Jays would be second if the season ended today with the head-to-head advantage over Juniata.

Abby Beyer came off the bench and recorded a team-high 19 points on 7-for-8 shooting. She was a perfect 3-for-3 from deep. **Veronica Christ** notched her first career double-double with 17 points and 12 rebounds. The freshman also dropped in three treys in the game. **Emma Hoesman** added 12 points and **Lydia Lawson** tied her career high with 8 assists.

Scranton has been the hottest team in the Landmark Conference since the start of December, currently on a 12-game win streak after a loss at Juniata in the conference opener. The Royals have participated in three separate tournaments, winning them all. They defeated King's (Pa.) and Wilkes in the Cross Country Challenge, beat Hartwick and #17 Messiah (in OT) at their home tournament in mid-December, and won both games in Nashville, Tenn. against Wheaton (Ill.) and Keene St.

Bridgette Mann is scoring at a clip of 15.8ppg, second-highest in the Landmark. Katie Feehery leads the league in field goal percentage (.593), while Mann and **Katie Broderick** are two of the top 5 shooters from three-point range. Mann leads the conference, Broderick is fifth. E-town claims two of the other three spots, with Beyer second and Lawson third.

- 4 Mikayla Ruth had a team-high 15 pts. at Scranton in the loss three week ago. Mann led 4 in double figs. with 21 pts.
- **5** Elizabethtown will host Scranton on Saturday, January 27, at 4 p.m.
