## THE STARTING 5

**1** This evening's game between Elizabethtown and Stockton marks the first time the two schools have faced each other on the hardwood. Both teams arrive with 6 wins on the season.

**2** Elizabethtown posted its first 90-plus-point outburst offensively last night since December 10, 2010 in a blow out 93-52 win over Hood. The Jays' 93 points were the most since scoring 94 against Wilkes in 2010 at Thompson Gym. E-town's 61 rebounds were the most since December 6, 1995, when they had 72 against Widener.

**Abby Beyer** had 17 first-quarter points and finished with a game-high 24 with a career-high 6 treys. **Emma Powell** (13 points, 11 rebounds) recorded her first career double-double. **Ashley Reynolds** (11 points, 14 rebounds) was went 10/10 for EC. **Veronica Christ** had 14 off the bench and **Lydia Lawson's** 8 assists were a new single-game high.

**3** Stockton won its home tournament on the opening weekend of the season with wins over Morrisville State and New England College. **Najha Treadwell** and **Sasha Williams**, two of the team's top contributors, were named to the All-Tournament Team. Treadwell is this week's NJAC Player of the Week for December 18-24.

Already a 1,000-point scorer for the Ospreys, Williams became the first player, male or female, in Stockton history to achieve over 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in her career. She hit the 1,000-rebound mark on Dec. 9, 2017. She also has a chance to become just the third NCAA Division III player ever to reach 500 blocks, with 477 to her name prior to the start of today's game. The senior is the three-time defending NAJC Defensive Player of the Year and two-time NJAC First Team Forward.

**4** Stockton head coach **Joe Fussner** is two wins shy of 400 for his career (398-277).

**5** After four of five December games at home, Elizabethtown will spend the next three on the road to begin 2018. E-town returns back to Thompson Gym on Saturday, January 13, when the Jays host Susquehanna at 4 p.m.
