LEADING OFF

1 Elizabethtown and Susquehanna are one of the oldest matchups in program history, dating back to 1930. The Blue Jays are 85-69 all-time against the River Hawks. E-town lost the regular season series last season 1-2 at Selinsgrove, Pa., but won 2 of 3 against SU in the Landmark Conference Baseball Championships, including the Landmark Conference title game, 6-2, for the school's first-ever Landmark baseball conference crown.

2 The Blue Jays were stymied offensively on Wednesday against Muhlenberg. A day after scoring 17 runs on 20 hits, E-town scored twice, both in the ninth inning, in a 10-2 loss to the Mules. **Anthony Knight** managed to extend his hit streak to 12 games with a single in the third inning. He continues to lead the team at .459. **Derek Manning** sits in second in the Landmark at .395.

3 Susquehanna went 3-10 in its first 13 games, but since March 28, have gone 8-6. The Riverhawks have also won 5 of their 9 Landmark Conference games and are currently tied with Drew for the third spot in the league standings.

Senior **Cole Luzins** leads the team in hits, doubles, home runs, RBIs, and runs scored. His 9 doubles are tops in the conference and his 5 homers are tied for second. Sophomore pitcher **Bobby Grigas** has had the top arm for the River Hawks. Grigas has a team-high 3 wins, 47 strikeouts, and 2.85 ERA. He also leads the staff in innings pitched and complete games.

4 Elizabethtown seniors **Anthony Lippy**, **Nick Lorenz**, **Brennan Snyder**, and **Colby Smith** will be honored tomorrow prior to the start of Sunday's series finale at 12 p.m.

5 After Susquehanna, E-town will head to F&M on Monday, April 23 for a 4 p.m. makeup game.
