#### **5 THINGS TO KNOW**

- 1 Elizabethtown is 23-9 all-time against Scranton, but lost last year's matchup at Scranton, 1-0.
- The Blue Jays overpowered Moravian in Wednesday's Landmark Conference tilt, 4-0, at Wolf Field. 1-0 at halftime on Grace Hardy's first goal of the game, E-town put in three in the second half to blow the game wide open. Hardy scored her second of the day for her first multi-goal game of her career. Maggie Fees extended her goal scoring streak to four games and Olivia Beachley scored her team-leading seventh of the season to cap off the shutout victory. Celene Desko recorded her first career point after being credited with the assist on Beachley's goal. Margo Donlin earned her Landmark-leading seventh shutout of the season and needed only two saves to do it. Overall, it was E-town's eighth straight win.
- Scranton comes into the day with an identical 11-2 overall record. The Royals started off 7-0 before dropping their Landmark opener to Catholic, 3-2, in double overtime. Grace McClatchy, Scranton's and the conference's leading goal scorer, has been a three-time Offensive Athlete of the Week. She is only one of three players with 10 or more goals, though teammate Elizabeth Tolley is one shy of becoming the fourth. Tolley also ranks top three in the Landmark in goals, assists, and points.

Defensively, goalie Jenna Cyr leads the Landmark in Goals Against Average, allowing a meager 0.68 goals against per game. Donlin is next with a 0.75 GAA.

Since joining the Landmark Conference beginning in the 2014-15 academic year, Elizabethtown has won 26 out of 32 regular season league games. E-town has won at least four of seven conference contests each of its first four seasons, and already with a 4-0 record in Landmark play this year, has made it five straight. The Blue Jays are 3-1 against the Royals in the regular season and 1-0 in the postseason. EC beat Scranton in the 2015 Landmark Conference semifinals, 1-0, at Wolf Field.

Elizabethtown will host Swarthmore on Wednesday, October 17, at 4:30 p.m.
