## 5 THINGS TO KNOW

**1** Elizabethtown and Washington & Lee met for the very first time last season in Lexington, Va. The Generals won 1-0 in overtime on **Annalise Thole's** game-winner.

**Margo Donlin** had 13 saves in the game while her counterpart, **Ariyel Yavalar**, made 3 saves.

**2** Washington & Lee, the defending champions of the Old Dominion Athletic Conference, were picked to win the conference in 2018, securing the top spot out of the nine-team league. The Generals were 15-5 overall a season ago, winning the second ODAC title in program history and advancing to the Second Round of the NCAA Division III Tournament. W&L returns 15 letterwinners from last year's team.

With 10 saves against Denison, Yavalar set a new program record for career saves (299) and can become the first goalie in school history to record 300 saves.

**3** Donlin's previous career-high in saves was the 13 she made last September at Washington & Lee. In this past Wednesday's game against Ursinus, the senior had her fifth career game with 10+ saves and finished the non-conference loss to the Bears with 14 stops.

**4** Elizabethtown has played eight of the nine members of the Old Dominion Athletic Conference in its history. The only league member the Blue Jays have not played is Virginia Wesleyan. E-town is 20-10 all-time against ODAC schools. The Jays have the following records against ODAC schools: Bridgewater (Va.) (5-1), Eastern Mennonite (2-4), Ferrum (1-0), Lynchburg (8-2), Randolph-Macon (1-2), Roanoke (1-0), Shenandoah (2-0), Washington & Lee (0-1).
