5 THINGS TO KNOW

1 Going back to 1976, Elizabethtown is 26-5-1 all-time against Wilkes. The Blue Jays have won seven in a row over the Colonels.

2 After a 2-2 start to September, and 3-2 overall, Elizabethtown has reeled off five consecutive victories. During the five-game win streak, E-town is outscoring their opponents 9-3 with three shutouts. For the third time this season and second consecutive week, goalie **Margo Donlin** was named the Landmark Conference's Defensive Athlete of the Week. Donlin kept the Jays in the game at Eastern and watched as **Lauren Scheib** recorded her first career hat trick in a 3-2 win. Then, on Saturday, Donlin shut out defending champion Juniata on the road, 1-0, as the Jays moved to 2-0 in the conference.

E-town also beat Washington & Lee (2-0), York (Pa.) (2-1), and Susquehanna (1-0 in OT) prior to last week's pair of wins.

3 The defensive work Elizabethtown puts in for 70 minutes each game has frustrated teams all year long and is a major reason for the team's 8-2 record. The .800 win percentage ranks tied for 21st in NCAA Division III. Only three times in ten games have the Blue Jays conceded multiple goals to their opponents.

While their exceptional play doesn't always translate to stats in the box score necessarily, the back line rotation of **Renee Grill**, **Maggie Fees**, **Tyler Wilson**, **Jesse Sartor**, and **Cecilia Carter** has been stout along with that of Donlin. As a defensive unit, E-town ranks top 20 in the country (Division III) in Goals Against Average (.87, 20th), save percentage (.839, 15th), and shutouts per game (.50, T13th). Donlin has five shutouts in ten games and the Jays have allowed just 9 goals all season.

4 Wilkes' senior **Haley Gayoski**, the team's points leader with 12, earned her first career weekly conference award, being named the MAC Freedom Offensive Player of the Week after helping the Colonels to a 2-0 record the week of Sept. 17. Gayoski scored the GWG at Moravian and had a penalty stroke goal that extended Wilkes' lead to 4-1 in an eventual win over Eastern in the Freedom opener.

5 Elizabethtown travels to face Drew on Saturday, October 6, at 1 p.m.
