Series Record: Elizabethtown leads 7-2 (W4)

ELIZABETHTOWN

The Blue Jays got their first conference win of the season last Saturday, beating Juniata 2-1 in double overtime at Wolf Field. The Eagles held a 1-0 lead, but **Katie Hatchell's** first career goal tied the game at 1-1 in the fourth quarter. **Anna Mostoller** scored the game-winner 34 seconds into the second OT.

Olivia Beachley scored twice against the Rangers last season in the Jays' 4-0 win, their fourth straight over Drew. **Madison Kubik** also recorded a goal in the game.

DREW

The Rangers enter today's game winless in their last seven and 0-2 in the Landmark Conference. Drew scored its' first win of the year in the season opener, a 3-2 overtime win at home over Sage. Drew handled Notre Dame (Md.) 6-1 back on Sept. 14 with five different goal scorers, led by a pair from **Lauren Zultowski**. The freshman is the team's leading offensive producer with five goals and 10 points this season.
