THE STARTING 5

1 Elizabethtown snapped a nine-game winless streak against Catholic in their first matchup of the 2018-19 season back on January 16 in Washington, D.C. with a 60-49 come-from-behind win.

2 After trailing by six points at the half, E-town outscored Catholic 40-23 in the second half behind 14 points from **Brandon Berry** and 13 from **Bryce Greene**. The Blue Jays drilled 8 of 17 three-point attempts. Green (3), Berry (2), **Michael Pastore** (2), and **Connor Moffatt** each knocked down treys for the Jays.

Berry led Elizabethtown with 21 points while Greene recorded his first double-double of the season with 20 points and 11 rebounds. Moffatt, second in the league in total rebounds and third in average, snagged a team-high 12 boards.

3 Catholic senior guard **Andre Mitchell** has posted eight straight games of at least 13+ points, including a pair of 30-point games in his last three. Mitchell, averaging a conference-high 20.9 ppg in Landmark games, went off for 36 points this past Saturday at Moravian. Mitchell hit 18 of 22 free throw attempts and shot 7-for-15 from the floor (4-for-8 3PT). He recorded 30 points (11-11 FT) against Susquehanna on Jan. 19.

4 In last season's matchup at Thompson Gymnasium, the Cardinals put up 52 points in the second half after trailing by nine at the half to beat E-town by 11, 84-73. **Jimmy Golaszewski** hit five treys and finished with 19 points. **Brandon Easton** had 11 points off the bench and **Riley Hayes** scored 10 and grabbed 9 rebounds.

Greene and Pastore each had 19 for the Blue Jays. Pastore was 5-for-6 from deep and Greene knocked down three of his own on five attempts. **Ethan DuBois** dished out nine assists in the game.

5 Elizabethtown will host Susquehanna on Saturday, February 2, at 4 p.m. The Jays will then be on the road for three straight Landmark Conference contests, beginning at Goucher next Wed. 2/6 at 7 p.m.
