## THE STARTING 5

**1** Elizabethtown is 4-4 all-time against their Landmark Conference opponent tonight, Goucher. The Blue Jays swept the season series in 2017-18 after earning a pair of double-digit wins over the Gophers.

**2** Thompson Gymnasium has seen its fair share of magical moments over the past few seasons and Saturday's conference tilt with nationally-ranked Scranton was no different. Tied at 64-64 in the final seconds, junior **Connor Moffatt** grabbed a defensive rebound on what could have been a potential game-winner by the Royals. Instead, Moffatt took the ball up the court and nearing the three-point line, launched a running shot as the final few tenths of a second ticked off the clock and swished it through the net to give Elizabethtown its first upset victory since 2003.

Junior guard **Bryce Greene** led the Blue Jays with a team-high 17 points against Scranton. He was one of three in double figures. Freshman forward **Zach Nannen** contributed 12 points and 10 rebounds, his first career double-double, off the bench. Moffatt finished the game with 11 points and 9 rebounds.

**3** Goucher closed out the 2018 portion of the schedule with three straight home games. The Gophers took some momentum into the New Year after winning two of the three. **Gabe Ceribelli** and **Pat Goralski** led five players in double digits for Goucher in a big 96-65 win over Christendom on December 8. A week later, Ceribelli (22 points) and **Dwayne Morton** (21 points) combined for 43 in the Gophers' 71-70 win over Cairn.

Ahead by two with 13 seconds to go, Morton canned two foul shots that gave Goucher a four-point lead. The makes turned out to be huge as Cairn hit a three-pointer with a second to go, but GOU would hold on for the one-point win.

**4** Moffatt, who averaged a double-double over his last 3 contests, was named the Landmark's Men's Basketball Athlete of the Week on Monday.

**5** After a pair of Landmark Conference games at home, the Blue Jays head out on the road this weekend, at Susquehanna on Saturday, January 12, for a 4 p.m. showdown with the River Hawks.
