#### THE STARTING 5

- 1 Elizabethtown and Juniata have met 155 times on the hardwood since 1929-30. E-town owns an 89-66 lead in the all-time series, though the Eagles have won the past two matchups.
- The Blue Jays went toe-to-toe with the top team in the Landmark on Monday in Drew. Bryce Greene had 13 of his team-high 17 points in the first half as E-town carried a five-point lead into the second half. The Rangers worked their way back into the lead behind Nate Aldrich's double-double. Drew pulled away over the last few minutes to remain unbeaten in the conference while the Jays dropped to 3-3.

Elizabethtown is currently tied for fourth in the standings with Catholic and Scranton, but have the head-to-head advantage with each team.

**3** Juniata led Scranton at the half this past Saturday and were up with less than seven minutes to go, but the Royals were able to get out of Huntingdon, Pa. with a five-point win. **Brandon Martinazzi**, one of the top point producers in the Landmark Conference, had a team-high 23 points on 10-for-17 shooting for the Eagles. **Paul Martello** added 13 points, but no other player had more than six for Juniata.

Martinazzi and Martello led the Eagles to their first conference win last Wednesday at Goucher. Though they trailed at halftime, Juniata put up 44 in the second half while holding the Gophers to 28 and ended up with a 13-point win. The two combined for 35 points while **Jake Holsopple** added 9 points off the bench.

- 4 In the last meeting at Thompson Gymnasium, Juniata shot 19-for-31 (61.3%) in the second half to blow open a game that was a one-point Elizabethtown lead at the half, 27-26. The Eagles posted 49 points in the second half alone on their way to a 75-48 win over the Blue Jays that night. Greene (11) and Michael Pastore (10) were in double figures for E-town in the game.
- **5** Elizabethtown will head to Scranton on Saturday, January 26, at 4 p.m. looking for the season series sweep over the Royals.
