## THE STARTING 5

- 1 Today's game features the first-ever matchup between Elizabethtown and Marywood.
- 2 Elizabethtown got back to .500 last Saturday, Dec. 8, after cruising to a 19-point win at Valley Forge to snap a two-game slide. **Bryce Greene** tied a season-high with 19 points with three treys to lead four in double figures for the Blue Jays. **Michael Pastore** hit all three of his shots from beyond the arc to climb into a first-place tie in the Landmark Conference in three-point field goals made (21). He also raised his season average from three-point range to .500, which ranks third.
- 3 Marywood has won four of five games played at home, but are winless in true road games. The Pacers are a +17.6 at home, averaging 83.4 ppg and holding opponents to just 65.8. Marywood posted three games with 90 or more points.

**Thomas Swartz** and **Jeremy Ringland** lead the Pacers offensively. Swartz is scoring at a clip of 18.7 ppg through 10 games. Ringland is also in double figures at 13.6. They are also one-two in rebounding while Ringland also protects the rim, blocking 3.0 shots per game, which ranks tied for 11th in all of NCAA Division III.

- 4 Last time on their home court, the Jays blew by King's (Pa.) 93-63. Pastore scored a career-high 26 points and as a unit, E-town shot 57.1% from the floor. The Monarchs led by a point a little over seven minutes into the game, but EC shook off a slow start and went on a 21-4 run to take command. Pastore knocked down five three's while Greene added three of his own and finished with 19 points. **Brandon Berry** and **Zach Nannen** added 10 each. Nannen (8) and Matt Thomas (9) combined for 17 rebounds in the romp.
