5 THINGS TO KNOW

1 Elizabethtown and Drew met twice during the 2017 season, once in the regular season and then in the Landmark Championship game in Madison, N.J. The Rangers got the better of the Blue Jays on both occasions. E-town leads the all-time series 16-10-3.

2 The offense showed up in full force last Saturday for the Jays. Elizabethtown recorded a season-high four goals, all by different players. **JD Haaf** one-touched a shot into the net after **Gilbert Waso** found the junior streaking into the penalty box. Haaf then assisted on **Jorge Sanchiz's** first career goal 59 seconds later. **Connor Rathsam** and **Brendan Burke** added second-half goals as E-town won their first Landmark game of the season, 4-0. Goalies **Brian Gately** and **Andrew McGowan** combined on the shutout of the Eagles.

3 Drew lost just three starters from last year's squad that finished 21-1-1, won the Landmark Conference Championship, and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA DIII Tournament. The Rangers tied the school record for wins and went 12-0 at home.

Junior **Aidan Cserhat** piled up 20 goals and 5 assists in his first season with the team last year and became just the second United Soccer Coaches (USC) First Team All-American in program history. He was First Team All-Region, ECAC Rookie of the Year, Landmark Offensive Player of the Year, and Landmark Rookie of the Year. Cserhat currently leads the conference in goals (9) and points (21).

Goalie **Jason Adamo** is the only keeper in the league holding a sub-1.00 Goals Against Average, at 0.98. Drew is outscoring teams this season 26-10.

4 In Elizabethtown's last home game on Ira R. Herr Field, **Garrett Winchilla** equalized for the Blue Jays against Alvernia, who held a 1-0 lead into the 81st minute, when Winchilla scored his second of the season from about 30 yards out. The Jays and Golden Wolves went to double overtime and tied 1-1.
