5 THINGS TO KNOW

1 Elizabethtown is unbeaten against Penn State Harrisburg, winning all three matches in the all-time series. The first matchup between the two schools was played in 1982.

2 The Blue Jays swept Neumann in their last home match by set scores of 25-16, 25-20, 26-24. E-town had eight service aces against the Knights, the 10th time this season they've had at least eight aces in a match. **Raleigh Hudock** lead the team with three, while **Sarah Schneider** and **Jenna Harne** each had two.

3 Elizabethtown had their fourth-best attacking percentage of the season on Saturday against Goucher in the Landmark Crossover at Scranton. The Blue Jays fell to the Royals before coming back later in the day to beat the Gophers. EC tied a season-high with 48 kills and hit .252 in the four-set victory.

Mackenzie Garner had a team-best 15 kills. Schneider had 11 and **Elle Shatto** contributed 9 for the Jays. Defensively, the Landmark's leading blocker, Garner, had 5 blocks. Schneider and Shatto shared in the team lead with 12 digs apiece and **Aiyana Tietze-DiTorro** had 11.

4 Penn State Harrisburg has traded wins and losses their last four matches, getting victories over Cheyney (3-0) and Albright (3-0) and falling to Lebanon Valley (3-0) and Salisbury (3-0). The Lions are 1-1 in the Capital Athletic Conference, beating St. Mary's (Md.) (3-2). The loss to the Gulls this past Saturday was their first league setback.

Junior **Brittany Wolf** became the program's all-time kills leader in the Lions' win over St. Mary's. PSH was down 2-1 in the match before winning the final two to take the match. Wolf had 16 kills against St. Mary's before adding another seven against Cheyney the same day. **Kristin Waring** recorded 73 assists between the two matches and leads the team with 370 for the season.

5 Elizabethtown heads to Lycoming for the Warrior Tip-Off Classic on Friday (10/5) and Saturday (10/6). The Jays play Lycoming and Medaille on Friday and Rochester (NY) and Penn St. Behrend on Sat.
