- 1 Today's non-conference matchup between Elizabethtown and the United States Coast Guard Academy is the first-ever meeting between the two schools.
- **2** After shooting a season-low from the floor in their last home game, E-town posted their two best shooting performances their last two games, both wins. At Marywood on Sat. Dec. 15, the Blue Jays hit 29-of-63 shots (.460) and after an early deficit, cruised to a 73-59 win over the Pacers. **Lydia Lawson** led the way with a team-high 22 points, 6 assists, and 7 steals. **Roni Isenberg** added a season-high 18 points (9-13 FG) in the game.

Elizabethtown came out on fire against Marymount (Va.) in their 2018 finale on Dec. 17. The Blue Jays scored 19 points in each of the first two quarters and jumped out to a commanding 38-15 lead at half-time. The Saints made it a game in the third quarter, but E-town pulled away in the fourth to record another 14-point win, 69-55, over d3hoops.com preseason No. 16 Marymount. Veronica Christ led four in double figures with 19. Mikayla Ruth (13), Marissa Emlet (11), and Lawson (10) aided the cause with double-digit points. E-town also shot a season-best 48 percent from the field.

3 Coast Guard began the month of December with a lopsided win over Wheaton (Mass.) in conference play. The Bears led Wheaton by nine at the half and outscored them in each of the two remaining quarters, including 28-13 in the fourth. CGA had six players register at least 10 points in the win, including a team-high 19 from leading scorer Micaela Martinelli. Johanna Moolenaar had 14 to lead the reserves. Breanna Wood and Kyra Hartman had 11 apiece and Emma Puddington and Annabella Farabaugh both recorded 10 each.

Coast Guard shot 42.3 percent from the floor, their third-best output on the season. They shot over 50 percent, 51.2, against Mount Holyoke on Nov. 28 in a 101-41 win.

- **4** USCGA, out of New London, Connecticut, have reached the NEWMAC in each of head coach Alex Ivansheck's first six seasons. The Bears were 13-13 a season ago and 7-9 in the NEWMAC.
- **5** The Blue Jays will remain at Thompson Gymnasium for a matchup with Scranton on Saturday, January 5, at 2 p.m.
