- Flizabethtown heat Goucher on January 9, 81-48, but the final score doesn't tell the whole story. The Gophers trailed by a point at halftime, 31-30, before the Blue Jays opened up the game by going plus-24 in the third quarter.
- E-town had plenty of reasons to celebrate this past Saturday. The Jays hosted their Alumni Day and welcomed back the 1989 National Championship team as well as a few former players that graduated between 1950 and 1964! Elizabethtown celebrated 90 years of women's basketball with a post-game ceremony recognizing those alumni and their accomplishments.
- Elizabethtown trailed early against Susquehanna after the River Hawks started out hot from the field. The Blue Jays hung close and eventually took over the game. Lydia Lawson had her way with Susquehanna for the second straight game this season. The junior scored a career-high 37 on the road a few weeks back. She put up 25 points on Saturday and averaged 31.0ppg against the River Hawks this season. Veronica Christ added 13 and Mikayla Ruth posted 10 points in the win.
- Goucher may be winless in the conference, but they have given teams fits this season. Both of their recent games, home contests with Juniata and Drew, have been two-possession affairs. Alayna McFadden led three in double figures with 16 points in a six-point loss to the Eagles. Anise Williams had 13 and Jorryn Avery added 12.

The Gophers let a lead to start the fourth quarter slip away on Saturday against Drew. Goucher led 40-37 going into the final period, but the Rangers outscored the Gophers 18-10 to come out with a 55-50 win. McFadden again had a team-high with 18 points. Nicole Wolard posted 12 points and 17 rebounds and Williams was in double digits with 11.

The women's basketball team will be on the road for a pivotal Landmark Conference contest at Drew on Saturday, February 9, at 2 p.m.
