#### THE STARTING 5

- 1 Elizabethtown lost at Juniata a few weeks back on January 23, 70-63. **Veronica Christ** led the Blue Jays with 21 points in the loss.
- **2** E-town took care of business at home last Wednesday against Goucher and then went on the road for a pivotal victory at Drew on Saturday. **Lydia Lawson** led four in double figures for the Jays with 17 points and dished out a game-high nine assists. **Mikayla Ruth** and **Angie Hawkins** each had double-doubles in a 73-45 win over the Gophers. It was Hawkins' first career double-double.
- **3** Elizabethtown trailed by as many as eight in the first half against Drew, but the Blue Jays hung tough and worked their way back to a one-point deficit by halftime. Despite 25 points from Rangers' guard Julia Ramos, Lawson took over the second half with 17 points and helped lead a comeback win for EC to keep E-town slotted in the second spot in the Landmark Conference standings with a 9-3 league record.

Lawson averaged 20.5 ppg for the week and was named the Landmark's Women's Basketball Athlete of the Week for a second time this season.

**4** Juniata dropped its first three games of the 2018-19 season before winning their first on the second day of the Lebanon Valley College Tip-Off tournament. The Eagles defeated Bryn Athyn, 74-48, behind Gracie Stauffer's 24-point, 12-rebound double-double.

Juniata has traded off wins and losses in their last eight games, with their latest being a loss at Scranton this past Saturday. The Eagles currently sit in a tie for third in the Landmark with Moravian at 7-5.

**5** The women's basketball team will host Moravian on Saturday, February 16, at 2 p.m. in an all-important Landmark Conference matchup.
