Series Record: Elizabethtown leads 4-2

ELIZABETHTOWN

The Blue Jays have gotten off to a 3-1 start to the season. **Angie Hawkins** led the way with 22 points in a 69-57 win over Marywood on Nov. 9 in the season opener at Thompson Gymnasium. Veronica Christ has averaged over 20.0ppg in the last three games and is coming off a pair of consecutive double-doubles for E-town over the weekend at the Terry Greene Memorial Tournament. The Jays beat host F&M in the consolation after falling to William Smith in the tournament opener. All five starters, Lydia Lawson, Christ, Hawkins, Marissa Emlet, and Mikayla Ruth were in double figures as they pulled away from the Diplomats in the fourth quarter. Lawson was named to the All-Tournament team and Christ was named the Landmark's WBB Athlete of the Week (11/18).

CABRINI

The Cavaliers went unbeaten at the Stockton Tip-Off Tournament this past weekend with wins over Pitt.-Greensburg and host Stockton. Cabrini jumped out to a 26-5 lead over the Ospreys on Sunday and never looked back, routing the hosts by 21 points. Kate Lannon led all scorers with 14 points while Kate King provided 12 points off the bench. Ashley Tutzauer leads the Cavs in scoring through three games at 14.0ppg. Cabrini has opened the year with three straight wins coming into tonight's matchup.
