Series Record: Elizabethtown leads 52-23

ELIZABETHTOWN

Angie Hawkins tied a career-high for the Blue Jays this past Saturday at Drew with 25 points to lead E-town to a 79-76 win over the Rangers as they remained tied for first in the Landmark Conference. **Lydia Lawson** ended with a double-double of 17 points and 10 assists. **Veronica Christ**, the conference's leading scorer, had 18 points in the game. E-town split with Juniata last season with the home teams winning each of the regular season meetings.

Last Wednesday at Goucher, all five starters for the Eagles reached double figures in an 86-64 win over the Gophers. Juniata kicked off the game by outscoring Goucher 27-16 and then ended the game strongly with a 29-15 advantage in the fourth quarter. **Gracie Stauffer** led the Eagles with 21 points and 13 rebounds. **Madison Colyer** had 18 points, **Cassie Mock** finished with 13 points, including two treys, **Grace Long** had 12, and **Larissa Leonard** shot 50 percent from the floor and ended with 10 points.
